Artificial Intelligence Accelerating Bioscience

Date: July 20, 2019 (Saturday, 1:30 to 5:00 PM)

This year, CBA collaborated with Monte Jade West to host a workshop titled "Artificial Intelligence Accelerating Bioscience". At this workshop, we brought together experts in the emerging discipline of AI and machine learning for in-depth discussions on the fast-developing novel technologies that characterize adoption in the life sciences arena and its impact on patients, clinicians, and systems. The speakers consisted of academia, industry, investment, and legal executives that focused on IP and legal requirements, and how the role of technology and data can be leveraged to enhance knowledge for drug discovery and care delivery, thus improving the lives of patients. Dr. Samuel Chen, CEO of AiXMed talked about AI trends in healthcare; Dr. Andrew M. Radin, Co-Founder of TwoXAR talked about AI in medicine, such as diagnostics and drug discovery; Dr. Possu Huang, Assistant Professor of Bioengineering, Stanford University presented his pioneer work on Computational design of de novo proteins; Dr. Sue Xu, Managing Partner at Amino Capital talked about AI in Healthcare from a perspective of an investor – How to Cut Through the Hype and Stephanie M. Brooker, Associate Attorney at Jones Day talked about the Potential IP Protection Strategies of AI in biotech.
